EC WARNING CARD
EQUESTRIAN CANADA SECTION A - GENERAL REGULATIONS

- **A Recorded Warning** may be issued by a Judge, Steward, or Technical Delegate at a competition to any person for minor offenses, including behaviour that should not be repeated and that does not warrant a more severe penalty.
- **A Yellow Warning Card** may be issued to any individual sport licence holder at an EC-sanctioned competition for improper conduct or noncompliance with EC rule, when the misconduct is not a minor offense but not severe enough to warrant formal disciplinary action by EC.
- Elsewhere in the EC rules certain additional conduct may result in an EC Recorded Warning or Yellow Warning Card being issued
- **The issuance** of a Recorded Warning or Yellow Warning Card is final and not appealable.
- Warnings will stay on file with EC.
- **Should an individual receive three Recorded Warning within 365 days the individual will be suspended for two months.**
- **Should an individual receive two Yellow Warning Cards within 365 days that individual shall be suspended for four months.**
