5) DRESSAGE: (2016 EC Eventing Tests): PE: Entry Test 1; E: Test 2; PT: Test 2; T: Test 2. Arenas: 20x 40m. Sand footing for dressage rings and warm-up.

6) CROSS COUNTRY: PE: 1500m @ 350mpm, E: 1750m @ 350mpm, PT: 2000m @ 400mpm, T: 2300m @ 450mpm (distances are approx). Terrain: Excellent rolling terrain with sandy loam footing. All courses inviting with high quality fences and **suitable for horses confirmed in their level in all divisions.**
